Presentation: "EchoLink and Modern Digital Modes" by David Hunter W7MKY

EchoLink – an internet linking for amateur radio; there are apps for smart devices and PC. You will need to have a ham radio license and an official PDF copy of your FCC license. EchoLink uses VoIP Voice over Internet Protocol; primarily windows based application and it is free, available at: http://www.echolink.org. There's also EchoLinux and EchoMac. EchoLink can be operated between two computers connected to internet using PC soundcard with speakers and microphone, and it can be interfaced as a "Simplex". One of the slides showed a list of the stations by country, call zone, etc. David did a demo using EchoLink.
