Presentation "Designing and Building Band-Pass Filters" by Dave Gipson KC9EI

Dave provided an overview of how a band pass filter works and why we use it. Briefly, band pass filters combine low and high pass filters allowing specific frequencies to pass through; one of the illustrations showed frequency (MHz) and transmission (dB). He also mentioned types of filters, capacitance, inductance, reactance, resistance (remember OHm's Law?) – the presentation had illustrations, schematics, formulas – it was a good review and helped expand some of our technical knowledge. Band pass filters are also useful in ham radio, in noisy environments when radios operate close to each other, i.e. Field Day, POTA - it helps eliminate interfering signals. Dave mentioned the ARRL Field Day "1000 Rule" – all equipment, including antennas must be within a circle whose diameter does not exceed 1000 feet. Also, it was interesting to find out, as several of us did not know - Ed Wetherhold W3NQN, ARRL Technical Advisor had designed the band pass filter, which became the standard and companies make them. Dave brought an electrical reference, UGLY's - you can check the website at: https://www.uglys.net/uglys-products. As a Club Project, Dave offered to provide us with hands on building experience – learn more about band pass filters; date will be announced – will keep you posted.
